Rules & Judging Information

Entry Forms :

Due on or before March 24, 2012.

Registration will be closed at 12:45 pm on March 24, 2012.

Each category is limited to twenty (20) contestants and is determined by the first-come, first served sign up.

Entrants must bring their own pooper-scooper and water dish

Entrants are not permitted in other areas of school building.

Entry Fees:

\$5 + \$1 for each additional event.

Any entry fees paid on the day of the event will be charged \$8 + \$1 for each additional event.

Arrival Time:

Plan to arrive 15 minutes before the event you have entered.

Pets must be on a leash.

The pet's owner must be the person who shows the pet.

The pet owner is responsible for providing all props needed.

Judging:

March 24, 1:00 until the end of the event.

Contestants will be called to the judging area.

Contestants will be judged by a panel of 3 or 5 judges.

Winners will be announced at 4:30.

All judges decisions will be final.

The winner of each category will be awarded with a prize.

- 1. Any inhumane or other inappropriate action to animals by the contestant may cause disqualification, forfeiture of awards and removal of the contestant and animal.**
- 2. Animal health decisions will be made in the best interest of the animal and for the other animals at the event.**
- 3. No animal shall be admitted or remain on school property that shows any evidence of any active communicable disease.**
- 4. No animal shall be admitted to the school grounds from any premises under quarantine for disease.**
- 5. All contestants must comply with all state and federal animal health regulations.**
- 6. Animals must be under the control of the handler at all times. Aggressive or uncontrollable animals may be removed from the competition and asked to leave the fairgrounds.**
